MISSION STATEMENT AND GOALS

The present-day Polish Nobility Association Foundation was created at the end of World War I. A small group of Polish-Lithuanian nobles established the Association with its present-day mission.

The membership was open to anyone whose name was associated with and listed in books of nobility of the Commonwealth of Two Nations, Poland and Lithuania. One of the original goals was the establishment of an independent Poland-Lithuania as a democratic constitutional monarchy. Poland became a Republic in 1918 and activities were primarily devoted to genealogical and heraldic preservation. The Association continued until the end of World War II.

The Polish Nobility Association Foundation was reestablished in the 1960's in the U.S.A. and incorporated as a not-for-profit organization, and was recognized as a 501 (c) (3).

Today, membership in the Foundation (P.N.A.F.) is open to anyone interested in the Foundation's mission and goals. Members whose names are listed in the historical heraldic reference works in the P.N.A.F. College of Heraldry, Leonard J. Suligowski Heraldic Reference Collection, or other reference sources not currently in the Collection, may use the designation P.N.A. after their surname in correspondence, etc.

The following goals have been maintained faithfully as a continuation of the "Royal and Noble Stewardship of the Commonwealth of Two Nations," through some of the following activities:


- Establishment of the Polish Nobility Association Foundation COLLEGE OF HERALDRY

MEMBERSHIP

Many family names may be connected with more than one clan or shield. However, eligibility into the P.N.A. membership category rests in the identification of the listed surname, whether or not the arms (clan shield) is identified.
- 2. The Polish Nobility Association Foundation (P.N.A.F.): This category of membership is open to all individuals whose clan arms are not listed in the nobility reference sources of the Polish-Lithuanian Commonwealth, or institutions, such as libraries; other Nobility organizations; Monarchist organizations; etc. All P.N.A. members are automatically members of the Polish Nobility Association Foundation.
